Introductions:

Local Planning Process:

The Local Planning Process for 2011 was discussed. The NERC TPL standards assessment will be completed in August 2011. This year the TPL studies will be evaluated on the 2012HS3 near term case and the 2016HW2a long term case. Since no system changes have been made the study results are expected to be very similar to past study results.

The changes in TTC's for the Deseret system were discussed. Generally the new MOD standards required a reduction in the TTC on the 138 kV system. But the new TTC's will become effective on 3/29/2011.

The change in the administration of the Deseret OASIS was discussed. Deseret is in the final process of getting the contracts in place for the day to day administration of the OASIS and the OATI contract for the OASIS software system. The switch over is expected around July 1.

Deseret has no active transmission service requests.

The next meeting will be in June of 2011.
