

Contemporaneous Disclosure

Pursuant to Sections 7(a)(1) and 7(a)(2) of the NLSO Code of Conduct, if the NLSO or an NL Transmission Owner discloses non-public Transmission Function Information, other than information identified in Section 7(a)(2) of the NLSO Code of Conduct, in a manner contrary to the requirements of the Code of Conduct, the NLSO will promptly post information about such disclosure on OASIS and make this information available to other requesting Transmission Customers. Additionally, if the NLSO or an NL Transmission Owner discloses, in a manner contrary to the requirements of the Code of Conduct, non-public information about a Transmission Customer, Critical Energy Infrastructure (CEII), or any other information that by law is subject to limited dissemination, the NLSO will promptly post information about such disclosure on OASIS.
