April Meeting

- OVEC presents the latest Transmission Plan
- OVEC requests information from Stakeholders on projects, expansions, or other considerations to include in developing the next Transmission Plan
 - Thirty days from the date of the Planning Meeting to submit comments or information

October Meeting

- OVEC provides draft of proposed final Transmission Plan for review and comment
- OVEC finalizes Transmission Plan
 - Draft plan provided the committee thirty days prior to meeting
